

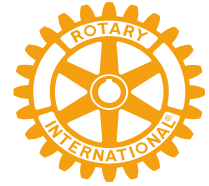

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Purchase of 7 multiparameter monitors for the **National Maternal-Perinatal Institute**, the largest maternity hospital in Peru and the third in Latin America and a reference center specialized in the maternal-perinatal field.

The monitors are used to measure the following parameters of newborns:

- Oxygen saturation pressure
- Heart rate
- Blood pressure
- Electrocardiogram
- Temperature
- CO2 partial pressure

- Provide health services with quality, efficiency and opportunity to the newborn

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

- Reduce newborn mortality rates
- Reduce morbidity rates in newborns

POPULATION BENEFITED BY THE PROJECT



The **National Maternal Perinatal Institute (NMPI)** is located in the center of Metropolitan Lima and its area of direct influence includes the **city of Lima** but, as it is a reference hospital center, its scope is **national**.

The pregnant mothers who are cared for at the NMPI belong to **socioeconomic levels D and E**. There are an average of **19,000 births per year**.

The average age of pregnant mothers is 25 years and 19% are adolescents.

PROJECT: SAFE MILK FOR NEWBORNS

PROJECT DESCRIPTION



The **National Maternal Perinatal Institute (NMPI)** has a Human Milk Bank, where breast milk is collected, processed and distributed in heat-resistant glass jars. After use, these jars are manually washed, dried and sterilized.

This project proposes the purchase of a milk glass jars washer-sterilizer, in order to guarantee that the 1,436 daily jars with milk are provided to babies in good food safety conditions.

The Human Milk Bank service is provided to preterm or lactating newborns whose mothers have contagious diseases or lack of milk.

PROJECT OBJECTIVES

GENERAL OBJECTIVE

- Provide mothers and babies cared for at the NMPI with a quality service

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

- Provide human milk to newborns and babies cared for by the NMPI in good food safety conditions.
- Reduce human contact when handling milk to avoid contamination.
- Assign technical personnel to other tasks that improve the quality of care for pregnant women and babies.





SERVE TO CHANGE LIVES



POPULATION BENEFITED BY THE PROJECT



The **National Maternal Perinatal Institute (NMPI)** is located in the center of Metropolitan Lima and its area of direct influence includes **the city of Lima** but, as it is a reference hospital center, its scope is national.

An average of 52 births are attended daily, of which **35 - 38 daily babies** are attended in the Intensive Care Unit due to problems with pregnant mothers or babies, who are users of the Human Milk Bank.

SUSTAINABILITY OF THE PROJECT

- The National Maternal-Perinatal Institute has competent medical and technical personnel in the proper handling of the equipment.
- The NMPI has the conditions of temperature, electricity, water pressure and the place where the equipment will be located is ideal for conserving the equipment over time.
- The National Maternal-Perinatal Institute will assign a budget for the preventive and corrective maintenance of the equipment.
